Don't get stuck with a repair bill—call 811 before digging

Last year hundreds of homeowners got a rude surprise: After digging into underground utility lines, they got stuck with the repair bill. Don't take a chance with your money or your safety. Call 811 two full business days before you dig—the day you call doesn't count—then dig by hand within 2 feet of the markings. Outline your dig area in white paint so that the utilities will know where to mark. Utility owned lines are marked for free.
