

Upcoming planned power outage notification

May 3, 2018

PSE electric crews are continuing to make great progress on the Highway 534 pole relocation project in conjunction with the WSDOT Strategic Highway Safety Plan. The crew is scheduled to energize the newly installed system the first week of May and change over the lines that serve your neighborhood; due to the complexity of the work, it will require a significant scheduled planned power outage; this will ensure a safe work environment for our crews as well as for the public. Please see below for planned outage details.

Planned power outage details

Date:	Overnight Friday, May 4
Duration:	Up to twelve (12) hours
Time:	Between 9:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m.
Location:	Hwy 534-area east of I-5 to past Lake McMurray including Lake Associates Recreation Club and Brotherhood Rd/Avalone Hide Away Rd, south to County Line Road/332 nd ST NW, north to Sinnes Rd (please refer to map on reverse for approximate area)

What you can expect

- As soon as the work is complete, power will return to your residence or business automatically
- There will likely be some noise from trucks and flashing lights in the area during work hours
- Traffic control signs and flaggers will guide vehicles and pedestrians safely through work zones
- Note: if you are receiving this notice via mail or email, your residence or business is impacted
